

- Same geological region as new gold discoveries at Ulysses, Admiral-Butterfly, Orient Well and Puzzle deposits by Genesis Minerals.
- Extensive historic gold mining between 1895 and 1922 Cosmopolitan historic gold production amounted to more than 331,000 ounces of gold1 at 15g/t.
- Corporate consolidation underway in region.




McTavish East

- * Further potential for very highgrade shoots to be identified in existing wide spaced drilling.
- Untested aircore drill targets along 2km trend








Forward Programmes

- Diamond drill down dip of high-grade zone,
- RC infill earlier high-grade intercepts to the south within McTavish East, other aircore targets to the North.
- Build high quality maiden JORC resource.
- Initial metallurgical results excellent with 97-99% recovery in leach tests further preliminary metallurgical and geotechnical work ongoing.
- Undertake Economic evaluation of mining potential based on open pit and underground mining. Truckable to nearby plants.








Cosmopolitan Long section

- Plunging shoot geometry







Kookynie Gold Project - Bumper gold grades








